Did You Know?

- * The City received a \$245,000 grant in 2023 from the SCA program to resurface Metolius St., Geneva St. and Opal Springs St.?
- * The City adopted a Safe Routes to Schools planning document which identifies needed safety improvements in the city.
- * The portions of Iris Lane and Elbe Drive that are in the city limits are now under the ownership of the city?
- * The City is now working on Phase 2 of managing the flooding with a Stormwater Master Plan which will identify the needed improvements and costs. (Project phasing is expected.)
- *The city has a Code Enforcement Officer dedicated to working on nuisance issues?
- *The city adopted an ordinance regulating animals in the city limits? It can be found on the city's website.
- *The city partners with other entities to share equipment thereby eliminating the need for duplicate purchases in the area whenever possible? (Thank you to our partners.)
- * The city has an agreement with Deer Ridge Correctional Facility for inmates to help the city with special projects when needed?
- * The budget process is regulated by State Law and two public hearings are required so everyone is given an opportunity to comment on the city's finances? The first public hearing is in April.
- * The Community Room at City Hall is available to rent on a first come basis for special events?
