## DESCRIPTION OF COMMITTEES

### **All Committees are subject to Public Meeting Laws.**

**Budget Committee** – The Budget Committee consists of the city council and seven city residents. The committee meets only a couple of times a year, generally in April, to review the proposed budget and make recommendation to the city council. The appointment is for a three-year term and you must be a qualified elector (i.e. registered voter) of the city.

**Planning Commission** – The planning commission is a five-member board appointed by the Mayor whose primary purpose is to deal with a wide variety of land use issues within the city. Examples of duties include reviewing ordinances, taking public testimony, deciding upon subdivisions and other land use applications. Members are required to file an annual Statement of Economic Interest with the state.

**Advisory Committees:** These committees are appointed by and advisory to the City Council. They are generally limited in nature and disband once the recommendations have been presented to the City Council for action.
