Culver City Council Meeting Summary

The council met on June 26th and the actions taken include:

Approving the minutes and financial reports * Declaring a vacancy on the Park Committee * An ordinance regulating camping on public property was approved * The first reading of an ordinance updating the city's Flood Hazard Ordinance was approved * A resolution approving a Personal Services Agreement with Content Capture for technology services and upgrades was approved * A resolution adopting the budget and another declaring the city's election to receive state revenues was approved * A resolution to utilize workers from the Oregon Department of Corrections for special projects was approved. * Permission was granted for vendors to use the city's Culver Crawdad Festival logo.

In addition the city heard reports including: * Receiving an update from Public Works * The attorney explaining the process following receiving a Letter regarding the approval of Shorty's Taphouse by the Planning Commission * The council discussed a City Sign including what both Prineville and Redmond paid for their signs that extend across a local street. *The Mayor reported on meeting with the Fire Department and provided an update on the Community Center Concept Plan and the work by the Culver High School students.
