It is the policy of the city to plow the snow from the streets to provide the most benefit to the residents.

It is also the policy of the city to assist the residents as much as possible giving priority to those with the highest need. There are residents with medical needs, please notify city hall.

When snow accumulation reaches 6 inches, or 4 inches and weather forecasts continued snowfall, Culver Public Works will begin plowing the snow. If you would like a copy of the adopted policy, please contact city hall.

Please help during snow events by:

1. Placing snow to the right hand side of the driveway as you look at the street. Do not place snow in the street.
2. Park all vehicles in your driveway, if you park on the street be as close to the curb as possible. Please park off the pavement.
