

**RESOLUTION NO. 22-06  
CULVER, OREGON**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE REFERRAL OF THE ORDINANCE  
DECLARING A BAN ON PSILOCYBIN SERVICE CENTERS AND THE  
MANUFACTURE OF PSILOCYBIN PRODUCTS TO THE VOTERS**

**Whereas,** The Culver City Council has adopted an Ordinance Declaring a Ban on Psilocybin Service Centers and the Manufacture of Psilocybin Products; and

**Whereas,** the Ordinance must be referred to the voters at a statewide general election.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Culver resolves:

1. The City Council refers to the November 8, 2022 election a measure proposing a ban on psilocybin service centers and the manufacture of psilocybin products.
2. The City Council adopts the following ballot title for referral:

**BALLOT TITLE**

Prohibits psilocybin-related businesses within the City of Culver.

**QUESTION**

Shall the City of Culver prohibit psilocybin-related businesses within city limits.

**SUMMARY**

State law allows operation, manufacturing, distribution, and possession of psilocybin and psilocin. State law provides that a city council may adopt an ordinance to be referred to the voters to prohibit the establishment of any of those registered or licensed activities.

Approval of this measure would prohibit the establishment of psilocybin product manufacturers and/or psilocybin service center operators within the areas subject to the jurisdiction of the City of Culver.

3. The ballot title adopted by this resolution shall be filed with the city elections officer, also known as the City Recorder. The City Attorney and the city elections officer are jointly and severally authorized and directed to take all necessary steps for and on behalf of the City to effectuate this resolution, including by providing public notice and submitting required materials to the county and city elections officers so as to cause the measure to appear on the ballot for the November 8, 2022 election and to otherwise carry out the intent and purpose of this resolution.
4. The City Council adopts the following explanatory statement for publication in the voters' pamphlet for the November 8, 2022 election:

## EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Approval of this measure would prohibit the establishment and operation of psilocybin-related businesses within the City of Culver.

A city council may adopt an ordinance prohibiting the establishment of psilocybin related businesses within the city, but the council must refer the ordinance to the voters at a statewide general election. The City of Culver City Council has adopted an ordinance prohibiting the establishment of psilocybin-related businesses within city limits and, as a result, has referred this measure to the voters.

If approved, this measure would prohibit psilocybin-related businesses within the City of Culver.
