Qualifying Requirements

- 1. Eligible properties are commercial, industrial, mixed-use, or live work buildings inside the Culver Urban Renewal District.
- 2. Eligible work includes color consultation services, masking tape, drop cloths, hand tools (brushes, scrapers, etc.), paint sprayer rental costs, paint and primer, paint brushes/rollers, paint pans/buckets, masonry preparation/preservation materials, wood preparation/preservation materials.
- 3. Ineligible work includes labor costs, routine building/property maintenance, landscape improvements, improvements to non-public faces of buildings, interior improvements, building acquisition, inventory or other working capital, administrative costs or payments to borrower, and new development or construction.
- 4. Property owner and/or business owner shall be in good standing with all City utility accounts, possess a valid business license, and be in compliance with all City regulations.
- 5. The Culver Urban Renewal District will provide up to \$3,000.00 in grant assistance per property. Businesses are to be responsible for all labor costs.
- 6. Program funding may be used one time per property unless the property has new ownership within five years since the last grant was awarded and the proposed project brings the property to a higher standard of improvement.
- 7. All applications shall demonstrate compliance with the applicable design standards, and shall in the public interest, encourage greater marketability of the district, and complement the existing historic downtown core, where applicable.
- 8. Funds shall be allocated based on the following criteria and are subject to availability, visual prominence of the building and its location, aesthetic quality design proposal, historical and architectural significance of the building, potential impact on the attractiveness of the City storefronts, the particular building, and the economic development of the downtown urban renewal district, and readiness to proceed.
- 9. The selected vendor(s) will invoice the District directly in an amount not to exceed \$3,000.00.
